## **SUPPLEMENT**

### DRESS-CODE

### A Dress-Code for WRRC-Officials:

In all competitions granted under these **Rules**, Supervisors, Observers, Judges, Tournament-Office-Manager and all other officials (including, but not limited to, any speaker, chairperson, scrutineer or other manager) serve as a team and shall dress or costume as follows:

**Men:** black business suit, dress shirt, black dress shoes without decoration;□

**Women:** black business suit with either skirt (covering the knees) or trousers, dress blouse or black cocktail dress.

On World- and Continental-Championships and on WDSF or together with WDSF organized competitions the WDSF Dress-Code for Judges will apply.

# **B** WRRC-Dress-Code for Competitors:

## WRRC DRESSCODE FOR ALL COMPETITORS IN ALL DIVISIONS AND AGE-GROUPS

- 1. The dress of all competitors shall be in good moral taste and suitable for the individual dance sectors and not carry any symbol which may be considered offensive.
- 2. Clothing may reflect the character of the dance and the music. Costumes, special effects and accessories, which take away the attention from the performance too much, are forbidden.
- 3. For safety reasons clothing and accessories taken onto the dance floor must not be intentionally thrown away there.

- 4. Costumes must cover the intimate parts of the dancer's body during the whole performance.
- 4.1 Intimate parts: buttocks, bust and pubic areas (see pictures 1)
  The intimate parts of the body must be covered with nontransparent material of any colour except skin-, tan- or flesh-color.

#### LOWER BODY:

- **4.1.1.1 Buttock:** The buttock is defined as the area from the crease between the leg and bottom up to the hip line across the body.
- **4.1.1.2 Hip line:** panties top line (how low)
  Straight horizontal line, top of line between buttocks muscles (interlineal line) must not be visible.
- **4.1.1.3 Panty Line:** panties bottom line (how high)

The panties' hip line should be high enough to completely cover the vertical crease between the buttocks.

The panties should cover the entire buttock in the back-side (see pictures 1). In the front, the panty line should follow the line between the body and flexed leg. The distance from the hip line to the panty line should be at least 5 centimetres when measured from the side (see picture 1).

Abbreviated bikini bottoms, thongs, thong appliqués and any shorts imitating a thong look are prohibited. The dancers should make sure their costumes fit properly, as ill-fitting shorts or panties can wedge or otherwise expose the buttock in a way that is prohibited.


### 4.1.1 UPPER BODY


**Main-Class:** Bikinis with skin-coloured or transparent material, which covered the torso, are allowed.

**Juveniles and Junior:** Bikinis are not allowed. The torso must be covered with non-transparent and non skin-colored material (see picture 2).


**Female dancers:** Abbreviated bikini tops, tube tops and tank tops are prohibited (see pictures 3). Exposing the breasts beyond is prohibited.

5. Specifically for acrobatic rounds because of safety reasons all body jewellery, including jewellery displayed in piercings, is forbidden. Large holes left from piercings should be covered with tape.
